

# Google Chrome Keyboard Shortcuts

To navigate windows and tabs in Chrome:

Action	Shortcut
Open a new window	⌘+N
Open a new tab	⌘+T
Open a new window in Incognito mode (enhanced privacy)	⌘+Shift+N
Reopen the last tab you closed (up to 10 of the most recent tabs)	⌘+Shift+T
Move to the tab in position (number)	⌘+(number) (1-8)
Close current window	⌘+Shift+W
Close current tab or popup	⌘+W
Go to previous page in browsing history	Delete or ⌘+[
Go to next page in browsing history	Shift+Delete or ⌘+]
Open home page in current window	⌘+Shift+H

To control text in Chrome:

Action	Shortcut
Copy highlighted text	⌘+C
Paste text	⌘+V
Paste unformatted text	⌘+Shift+Option+V
Copy and delete highlighted text	⌘+X or Shift+Delete

To control the address bar in Chrome:

Action	Shortcut
Perform a search on text in the address bar	Enter

<b>Open URL in a new tab</b>	⌘+Enter
<b>Highlight the URL in the address bar</b>	⌘+L
<b>Navigate drop-down menu</b>	Page Up/Page Down

## To control the current page in Chrome:

Action	Shortcut
<b>Print current page</b>	⌘+P
<b>Save current page (to your computer)</b>	⌘+S
<b>Reload current page</b>	⌘+R
<b>Stop reloading of current page</b>	⌘+,
<b>Open Find bar</b>	⌘+F
<b>Bookmark current page</b>	⌘+D
<b>Save all open pages as bookmarks in a new folder</b>	⌘+Shift+D
<b>Toggle full-screen mode</b>	⌘+Shift+F
<b>Scroll down the page</b>	Space
<b>Go to top of page</b>	Home
<b>Go to bottom of page</b>	End

## Miscellaneous shortcuts:

Action	Shortcut
<b>Toggle Bookmarks bar</b>	⌘+Shift+B
<b>Open History page</b>	⌘+Y
<b>Open Downloads page</b>	⌘+Shift+J
<b>Open Clear Browsing Data dialog</b>	⌘+Shift+Delete
