# How to Use iPad with Apple TV


## AirPlay video from your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch

1. Connect your iOS device to the same Wi-Fi network as your Apple TV or AirPlay 2-compatible smart TV.
2. Find the video that you want to AirPlay.
3. Tap . In some third-party apps, you might need to tap a different icon first.\* In the Photos app, tap , then tap .
4. Choose your Apple TV or AirPlay 2-compatible smart TV. [Need help?](#)

To stop streaming, tap  in the app that you're streaming from, then tap your iPhone, iPad, or iPod touch from the list.

\*Some video apps on iOS might not support AirPlay. If you can't use AirPlay with a video app, check the App Store for tvOS to see if that app is available on Apple TV.

## If video automatically streams to an AirPlay device

Your iOS device might automatically AirPlay video to the Apple TV or AirPlay 2-compatible smart TV that you frequently use. If you open a video app and see  in the upper-left corner, then an AirPlay device is already selected.

To use AirPlay with a different device, tap , then tap another device, or tap "iPhone" to stop streaming with AirPlay.

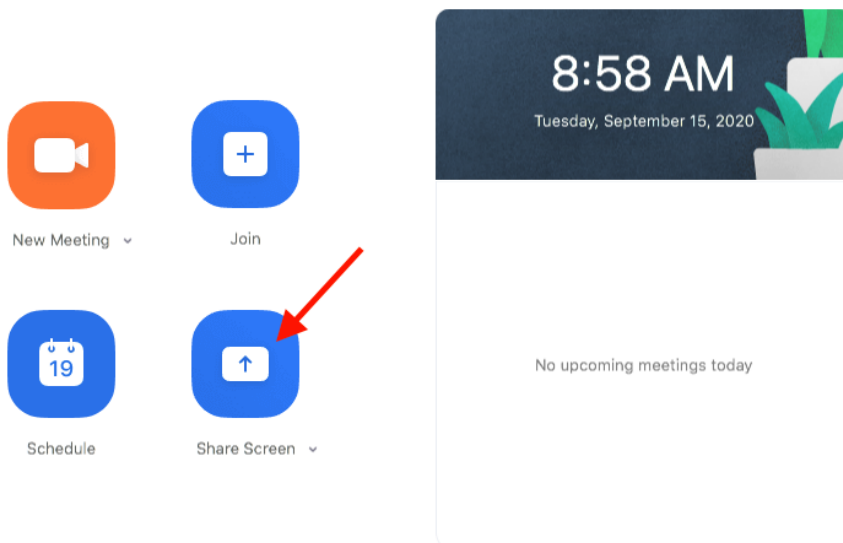
# Use iPad to Zoom in the Classroom

Step 1. Log in to the **Zoom App** on both your Macbook and your iPad.

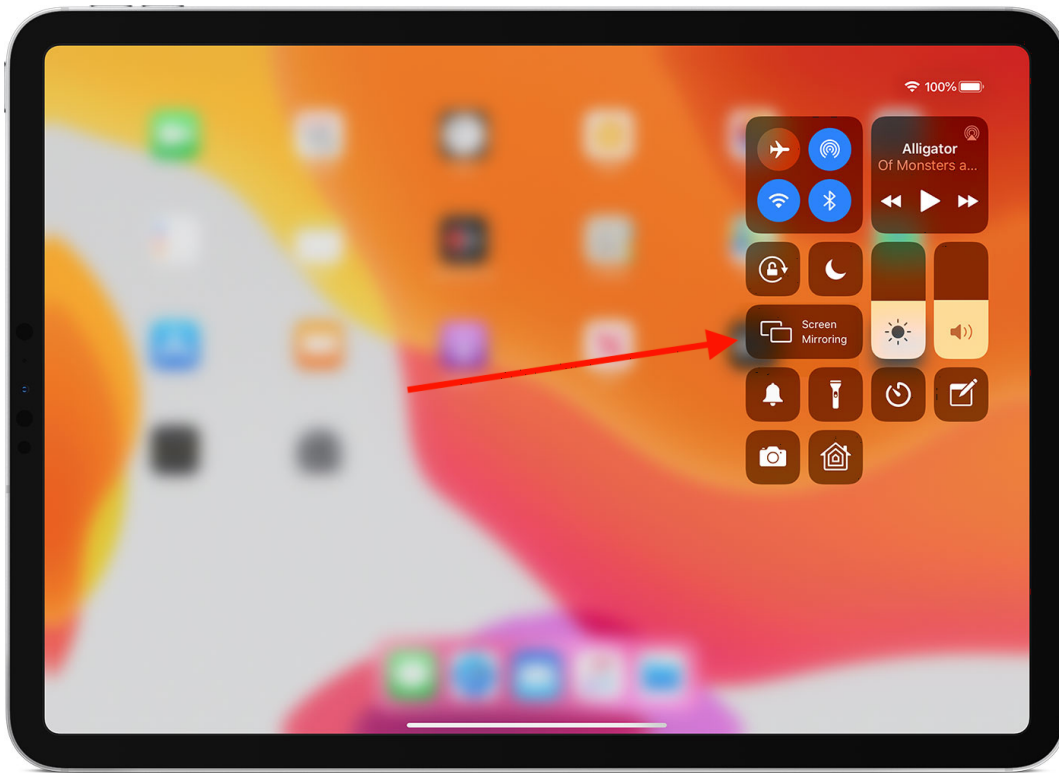
Step 2. Launch the Zoom App on the iPad, and start the meeting.

Step 3. Launch Zoom on your Macbook and click "Share Screen" (Pictured Below) and then you will need to find the Meeting ID on your iPad. Find the meeting ID on the iPad by tapping the word Zoom at the top of the screen. The meeting details will drop down.



Step 4. Enter the meeting ID on your Macbook, **then choose which window you want to share**, or click "desktop"

Step 5. Swipe down from the top right of the screen on your iPad and you will see the Control Center on your iPad.



Step 6. Click Screen Mirroring on the iPad (Pictured Above) and then choose your Apple TV.

**BELOW STEP IS ONLY NEEDED IF YOU ARE USING AN EXTERNAL MICROPHONE (THE BELOW STEP HAS TO BE THE FINAL STEP)**

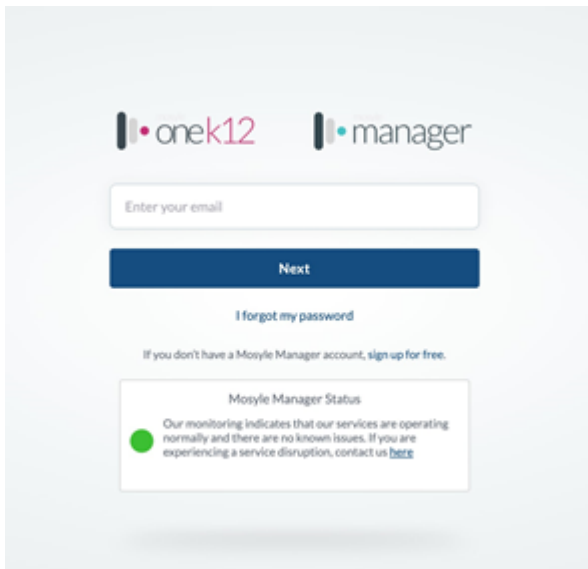
Step 7. Plug in your Microphone receiver to the iPad and turn the power switch on, and then turn on the switch power switch on the microphone.

# How to Reset iPad Passcodes

## iPad Passcode Reset Directions

1. Go to [myschool.mosyle.com](https://myschool.mosyle.com) and login with your provided login.

Note: Change the password for security purposes



2. Click, "Management," at the bottom of the screen to access the Device Enrollment screen

- Make sure the top left shows this image.



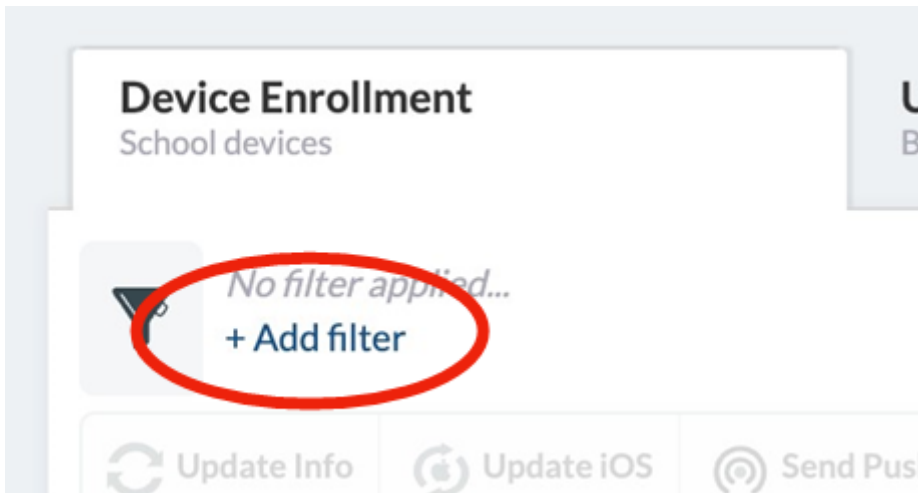

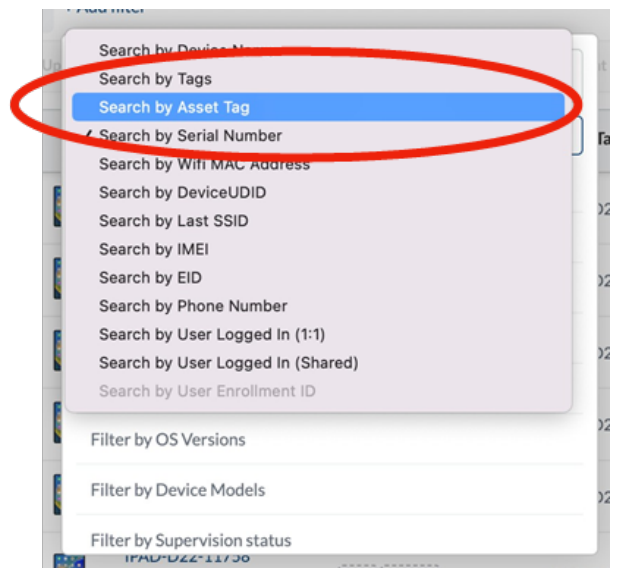
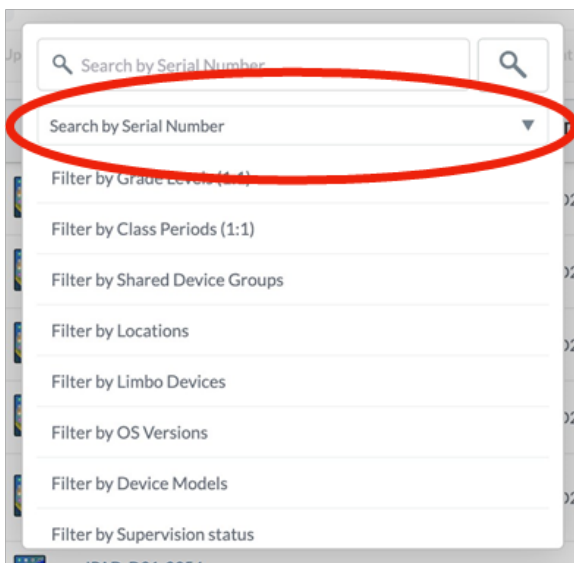
These directions will ONLY work for iPad Passcode purpose

- Do not worry about device names listed. Some may not list the asset tag, and that's not a problem.

3. Click +Filter under Device enrollment






4. Click the, "Search by Serial Number," dropdown and change it to, "Search by Asset Tag."



5. Type in or scan the asset tag

NOTE: Type the whole asset tag, not just the numbers at the end

6. Click on the device name (asset tag number). Make sure the correct student name is listed.

7. Click the, “More,” dropdown and choose, “Remove Lock Passcode.”

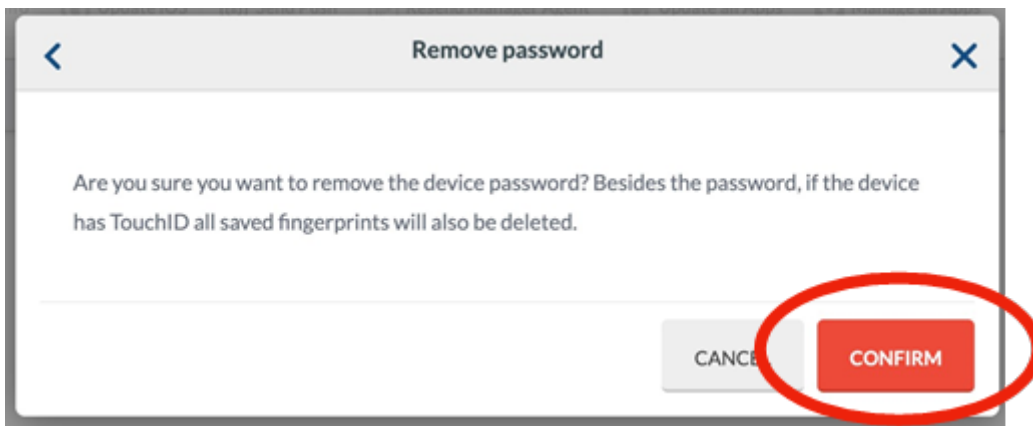

8. Click, “Confirm.”

This disables the passcode and sends a reset command to student iPad



9. Student iPad will get a message to reset the passcode. Click, "Change Now," and then enter new passcode.

Note: If student clicks, "Later," they will have 59 minutes to reset before they are forced to.
